Their production currently includes a Cabernet/Syrah blend, Syrah, Malbec, Pinot Gris, Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Gris Port and Cabernet Port (just about 1000 cases altogether), from some of the best grapes that Washington and Oregon have to offer. Their winemaking processes are risky, dangerous, and often painful, but the wine is worth it – ok, it's not actually all that risky or dangerous, but it is challenging and exciting, and they're thrilled to be able to share the results with you.

#### 9. Quilceda Creek Cabernet Sauvignon

A vertical of Quilceda Creek Cabernet Sauvignon from 1998, 1999, 2000. The 1998 vintage was the sixth hottest in the 46 years that records have been kept in eastern Washington. This resulted in ultra ripe fruit with

fully ripe, soft tannins and full fruit expression. According to Wine Spectator Magazine critic Harvey Steiman, Quilceda Creek's '98 Cab marks a historic turning point in the production of Washington State Cabernet Sauvignon, in which the wine reached its fullest expression. The '99 Cabernet Sauvignon is an infusion of black plum and spicy blueberries laden with anise, smoke, and minerals. This vintage is thick in extract with a wonderful syrupy texture displaying many layers of sweet lush fruit. The 2000 Quilceda Creek Cabernet Sauvignon is reminiscent of the '98, but on steroids. This wine is packed full of blackberry liqueur, plums, and crème de cassis laden with anise, smoke and Asian spices. It has a fabulous syrupy texture, showcasing the amazing purity of cabernet fruit found in this wine. It is the most perfumed and well-balanced Quilceda Creek wine to date.

Nikki McClure is known for her painstakingly intricate and beautiful paper cuts. Armed with an X-acto knife, she cuts out her images from a single sheet of paper and creates a bold language that translates the complex poetry of motherhood, nature, and activism into a simple and endearing picture. Her work depicts the virtues of hard labor and patience, which is inherent in her process as well as in the images themselves: weathered hands washing dishes, people sweeping, mothers caring for their babies, and farmers working the land. But there is also a large element of celebration-of taking the time to roll around in the grass and get wet from the early morning dew; the need for all of us to lay down on the ground, grab hold of the earth, look at the stars and dream.
